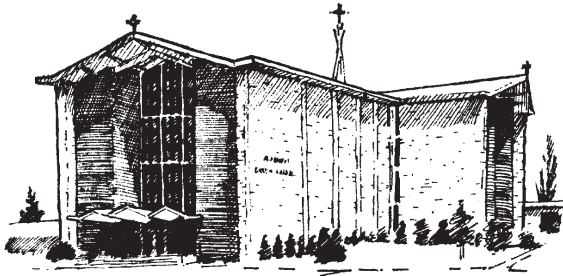

Jesus observes how some people take advantage of others. He watches a widow donate her last pennies to the lucrative Temple cult.
