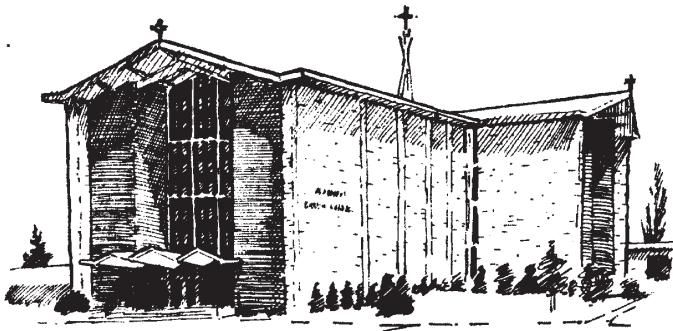

Father Cosmas' Reflection

The Spiritual Practice of Gratitude

It is very providential that on this Thanksgiving weekend, the readings presented to us from 2 Kings 5:14-17 and Luke 17:11-19 both speak of the beautiful virtue of gratitude. We randomly feel grateful throughout the year when circumstances line up just right. However, Thanksgiving helps us put a little more attention on gratitude for a short while before falling back into experiencing gratitude once in a while. As a spiritual practice, gratitude is something that we need to consciously engage in and experience. When we practice gratitude, our perspectives on life changes in a powerful way. The practice brings more joy and activates the spirit of appreciation in our lives. It aligns and opens us to the divine flow of abundance. The more we appreciate what has been given to us, the more we receive.

Both the story of the cure of Naaman in the first reading and the healing of the ten lepers in the Gospel reading have very obvious lesson, namely, the importance of showing gratitude. However, they also have the lesson of finding God through pain. When it becomes difficult for us to experience and express gratitude when life gets rough for us, we learn to find God through pain.

When we express our gratitude to God, we are reminded that everything we have we owe to him. When we look back over our lives and see the things that help us and the things that hurt us, let us try to see the helping hand of God in all circumstances and gratefully thank him for them all.
