### Call for Conscience Campaign Update

Thank you to all those who wrote letters, made phone calls and/or met with their Member of Provincial Parliament advocating for conscience protection in Bill 84, legislation relating to assisted suicide. Close to 30,000 letters were sent directly to our elected officials and many communities personally met with their local MPP on this issue. April 11, the Ontario Liberal majority on the Bill 84 committee voted to defeat Conservative Party amendments to protect the conscience rights of doctors/nurses. Therefore, no such protection will be in the legislation. We will continue to advocate for conscience protection moving forward and encourage you to share your concerns in any interaction you may have with your own MPP. Please continue to pray for all those impacted by issues of conscience and for all those who are sick and suffering among us. **Re: Arson at St. John  
the Evangelist Church**

On the early morning of  
Easter Sunday, April 16, 2017, an intentional fire was set  
inside the sacristy of St. John the Evangelist Church (49  
George St., Weston). Police released images to the public  
Sunday afternoon and the suspect was apprehended on  
Monday, April 17, 2017. While the fire was limited to the  
sacristy (area where priests prepare for Mass), the church  
interior has sustained significant smoke damage. We will  
provide a further update to the community later this week.  
We are grateful for the leadership of the parish staff, led by  
pastor Fr. Andrew Maderak. We also appreciate the  
tremendous efforts of our first responders and the thoughts  
and prayers that have been conveyed from throughout the  
community. Please continue to keep them in your prayers.
