Annual Financial Results

Included in this week's bulletin are the financial results for the 2014 year. As you are aware the last three years have been financially difficult for the parish. To help address the financial situation, in 2014, we had two town hall meetings and have received valued input from the parishioners.

In the bulletin, we are presenting the Statements of Receipts and Expenditures for both funds for 2012, 2013 and 2014 year. The finance Council has been reviewing ways to both increase the receipts and reduce our expenditure.

As part of this plan we had a campaign to increase the use of the preauthorized giving program and were successful in increasing the offertory for both 2013 and 2014.

We have also reviewed our expenditures and as you will note we have been successful in reducing our deficit from a high of \$151,000 in 2013 to just under \$69,000 in 2014. We have also decided to not do any major capital projects other than necessary repairs that must be undertaken.

What can we do as Parishioners:

- Please try to use weekly envelopes to make your contribution and if you are away please provide post-dated cheques.
- Consider using the pre-authorized giving program. This ensures that the parish will receive a payment from you, each and every month.
- Where possible, please increase your weekly amount. An increase of as little as \$1-2 per week per parishioner will go a long way to eliminating our deficit.

We appreciate that some of you may be going through financially difficult times but others may be in a position to now increase their support and just haven't had time to revisit the amount they are giving. Each contribution no matter how small is very important to the parish.

On behalf of the Finance Council we would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you for your contribution in supporting our wonderful parish.
