SUMMARY: Nurses and other healthcare professionals may increasingly face ethical situations at work in which, in conscience, they cannot participate. How does the healthcare professional proceed in such circumstances? Can the healthcare professional simultaneously maintain the regulatory body's standards of practice and uphold integrity of conscience? Which are the best ways of informing your manager and colleagues about your conscientious objection before a situation arises? What interventions should be avoided to prevent participation on the basis of conscience? What resources are available from CCBI and other organizations? In this seminar, an interdisciplinary panel of speakers will address these concerns.
