39th Annual Concelebrated Mass in Honour of Saint Patrick

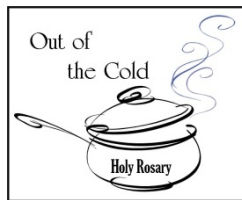

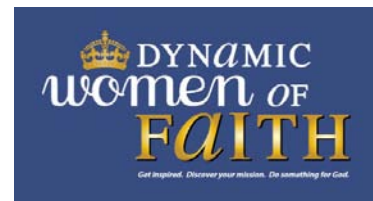
