***Catechetical Program** (Sunday School) resumes today, **Sunday, January 15th, 2017** after the 9:30 am Mass.

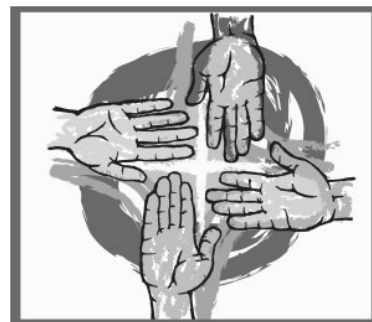
