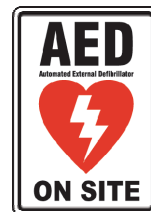

JUST A LITTLE Reminder

An AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is a device that is used to get a heart back to its natural rhythms by delivering an electrical shock to the heart during a cardiac arrest. If the person is **NOT BREATHING**, please stand up, interrupt the Mass and in a clear voice announce that we have a medical emergency. Ask that someone to call 911 and please tell them you are at Holy Rosary Church at 354 St. Clair Ave. West and immediately ask that someone else go to the Sunday sacristy to get the parish defibrillator and begin to treat the person appropriately for the condition until help arrives.



-The parking lot behind the Parish Hall is open on the weekends for parishioners to park their cars for Mass. To access the parking lot, you enter from St. Clair Ave. and turn right, right after the Parish Hall and continue up the laneway. You will see a sign stating, "Church Parking". If you choose to park on the street please read the signs to ensure you are parking in a designated spot, if you are not, you will receive a ticket from city.
