Dear Friends:

As we begin the Holiest Week of the year, I invite you to enter into this week with your heart and soul. Give time to God alone in prayer, and set time aside to celebrate with the community the **Easter Triduum**. Each celebration of the Triduum is special, and I hope that you will come and celebrate with us. Fr. David and I, the Pastoral Team and all the staff, the choirs and decorating committees of both sites, have worked hard to make this week's celebrations an opportunity to celebrate your faith with joy and devotion. We hope that you will join us for all the days of Holy Week. **Holy Thursday** is where we recall the Passover meal and the Lord's Supper. The emphasis of this special day is love and service. We celebrate here the great gift of the Eucharist, the heart of our faith. At this celebration, (both sites 7:00pm) the children preparing for Holy Communion will have their feet washed. **Good Friday** is the only day of the year that we do not celebrate Mass. Like last year, young people from our parish, will present the living stations of the cross, at both sites. **At St. Gregory Site 9:00am and 11:00am St. William Site.** Much time, preparation and prayer has been spent by these young people to help us walk the way of the Cross with Jesus. Good Friday is the day we focus on the Cross ~ Christ's cross and our cross. At the Solemn 3:00 pm service at both sites we recall the familiar story of Christ's Passion. We will have an opportunity to venerate the cross and receive Holy Communion from what was consecrated at the Mass of the Last Supper on Thursday evening. Please set time aside to join us for this special celebration in the life of our Church. On this day, along with members of the Church throughout the world, we fast and abstain from meat to honour the suffering and death of the Lord and to prepare to share more deeply in the joy of the resurrection. This year we will welcome two new members to our faith community through Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the **Easter Vigil**. Last year the turn out for this celebration was great, and I know that many left, appreciating the power of this sacred liturgy. I hope that many from both sites will come and join us for the **Vigil at St. William site (8:00pm) (note no 5:00 pm Mass)** and help welcome our new Catholics. A reception in the Parish Hall will follow. **Yes, the Vigil is your Easter obligation.** Throughout his Paschal mystery, Jesus redeemed the human race and gave perfect glory to God. By dying, Christ destroyed our death; by rising, he restored our life. For this reason, the Easter Triduum (3 days), when we celebrate the suffering death and resurrection of our Lord, is the high point of the year. The Easter celebration is to the year what Sunday is to the week. Each registered parishioner of Good Shepherd Parish has received our Holy Week Schedule in the mail and once again, we publish it for you in today's bulletin. With your mail-out, you received an Easter Envelope. Please give generously and help us continue to serve the needs of the parish.

May all of us during this Holy Week, experience God's love, through Jesus Christ.
