## CATHOLIC EDUCATION: REJOICING IN HOPE

Catholic Education Week will be celebrated from May 2-7. This year's theme, *Catholic Education: Rejoicing in Hope*, comes from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians where he writes, "Rejoice in the Lord always...and the God of Peace will be with you." (Phil. 4:4,9) During this week, schools will be celebrating the gift of Catholic Education with special prayers and presentations. We ask that the Parish continue to pray for our Catholic schools, that they may be marked by God's hope and joy. Contact your local Catholic school for more details.

**Dear Friends:**

Happy Feast Day to all of you on this Good Shepherd Sunday. We thank God for the gift of our name as a parish, and we continue to pray that Jesus Our Good Shepherd will bless our parish as we build for our future.

Last week was once again a difficult time for our Church, with the number of articles in the Windsor Star about sexual abuse. As many of you noticed, I was interviewed twice by reporters regarding how people in the pew have been affected by abuse and also regarding Fr. Godwin who served at St. William Parish in the past. Sexual abuse is devastating to each and every one of us, but especially to those who have been abused. I cannot find words in my heart to express how sorry I am for the damage that has been done to individuals and to the whole Church community by these men who were in positions of authority. As a Church and a society, we must do everything possible to end sexual abuse. I can say that Bishop Fabbro has been a great source of hope for me. As Shepherd of this Diocese he has made sure that everything is in place to help assure that there is a safe environment for all people, especially the vulnerable of our communities. The safe environment document is in place here at Good Shepherd parish and before anyone ministers to our children or our seniors, a police check must be in our files. I have made sure that the staff and pastoral team know the policy and follow it. During all sacramental preparation, parents are aware of these policies and that all groups in our parish know that this is a requirement. In my time with you, I have publically stated that if anyone in our Parish community has been abused by priests in the past to please come forward, either to authorities, to the Pastoral Team or to Fr. John Sharp who has been appointed to deal with all sexual abuse cases in our Diocese and who is chairperson of the Sexual Abuse Committee set up by Bishop Fabbro, to deal with any concern in this area. With the case of Fr. Godwin in the news I once again ask if anyone was abused by Fr. Godwin during his time at St. William Parish to please contact either myself, the diocese or authorities. We must put an end to abuse. Together we pray for those who have been abused and for their healing, and we pray for their abusers and for an end to all abuse.

In today's bulletin, it is also my task to speak to you about the annual St. Peter's Seminary collection. I would hope that you would recognize that in the midst of our sadness over sexual abuse, that there are many good priests who have served you and continue to serve you. As you know, the mission of St. Peter's Seminary is to educate and form future servant-leaders for our Diocese and the Canadian Catholic Church. I know that the faculty and staff of St. Peter's are committed to preparing Catholic leaders for their future ministry. The faculty forms and educates the seminarians and students on all levels; human, intellectual, spiritual and pastoral.

Over the years, priests and lay leaders have been able to serve you because of the preparation they received during their time at St. Peter's. This Annual Appeal is an opportunity for you to thank them for all they have done and to support the formation programs offered through the Seminary for those preparing for priestly ministry, diaconate service and lay leadership in our diocese. Over the years, I know that both sites have responded to St. Peter's annual collection with great generosity. Once again, I invite you to read the information provided in the pamphlet provided and to consider your donation to St. Peter's Seminary. You will find an envelope for this Annual Appeal in your box of Sunday Envelopes or you can pick up an envelope at the entrance of the Church. **Please make all cheque's payable to Good Shepherd Parish.** This way we will be able to keep track of our total collection for this year. Your gift will help the Seminary prepare men and women for servant leadership in the years to come. Let's try to be the top donation in Essex County or even the whole Diocese. I thank you in advance for your generosity. As we prepare for the Seminary collection, I thought it would be a good time to ask you to keep in your prayers those from our Parish who are in the Permanent Diaconate program; Mr. Frank Lepain (his picture and reflection is found in the pamphlet) and also Mr. Rick Heath. Also we pray in thanksgiving for the newly ordained. Both men are from the Deanery of Essex and are truly gifts to the life of our Church. We pray for **Father Patrick Beneteau** from St. Joseph's Parish, River Canard and **Father David Butler** from Ste. Simon & Jude Parish, Belle River. I ask you to please pray for your priests - these are very difficult times for us - and please pray as a family for vocations. May Jesus our Good Shepherd bless our Parish with many vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
