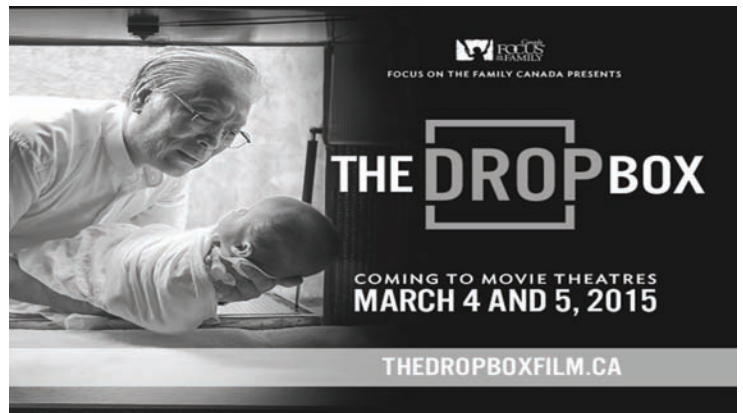


DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE brings *The Joy of the Gospel* for Share Lent 2015
