As many of you know, I was ordained to the priesthood on April 24th 2010, which means I have been a priest for just 289 days! A mere fraction compared to Fr. Gary who has been a priest for 11,607 days and Fr. Al who has been a priest for 20,336 days!!

Within 289 days of priesthood, I have experienced many blessings, surprises and have gone through a few adjustments...

Here are just a few of the highlights.

- 1) Being called Father – "Oh right that is me now!"
- 2) Wearing black all the time – "I am starting to feel like Bing Crosby in the *Bells of St. Mary*".
- 3) Moving from the sitting in the pew to standing at the Altar – "Priests make saying mass look too easy"
- 4). Remembering peoples names – "What is your name again?, for the third time..."
- 5). Turning 10 shades red when speaking in public - "Oh right I did that before I was a priest."

Humor aside, in my short time as a priest, I can honestly say that it has brought me great joy and it has been an honour to be at Good Shepherd Parish for my first assignment. I really enjoy spending time with you, hearing your stories and journeying with you during your joys and sorrows.

As I continue to learn and grow about what it is to be a priest and get settled into that role, I am thankful for all your love and support. I look forward to getting to know you better during the rest of my stay here; which speaking of is hopefully for a while longer... At least another 365 days or more!

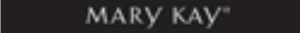
