Dear Friends;

Heather Bondy our financial secretary and longtime employee, is retiring this month. Heather has been a gift to our community and a joy to work with. We pray that this new time in your life will be filled with many blessings and more time with your husband, Ken, your children and especially those grandkids that you love so much. In early November when I told you that Heather was going to retire, I shared with you how we had planned to fill this important position and the fundraising office. After some time to evaluate our first thoughts of Anna Law and Janine Morris sharing these positions, the finance committee and I have decided that it was way too much to ask of them in their already very busy days, especially with the extra financial responsibilities that come with the start of construction of our new Church in 2012. So we have asked Mary Salmon, who is presently in charge of our fundraising office, to take on this new position. We are very excited that Mary has agreed to do this and has already begun to work with Heather so this transition will be smooth. Mary will now work Tuesday and Wednesday at the St. Gregory Site and I know that she will be able to handle any of your financial or fundraising concerns.

As we begin this New Year, I would like to speak to you about Masses being offered for your deceased loved ones or for special intentions. We have had a number of people requesting to set a mass each month for the whole year. Therefore, to help with problem, I am asking our secretaries to only book Masses three months in advance. I think this will help us with our problem. I thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
