At that time, you will be invited to sign up for a six week program where people gather in the homes of host parishioners for some life and faith sharing around the readings for the coming Sunday. It really is a great way to develop your faith be well prepared for the Sunday Eucharist and at the same time build some lasting friendships. The topic this Fall is entitled "Encountering Christ Today" and it looks great. I urge you to prayerfully consider joining your neighbours and even hosting a group. It just may be the boost for which you have been longing. Over the coming weeks, we will be giving you more information in the bulletin and from the pulpit and soon we will begin praying as a parish for its success. So... by all means stay tuned.

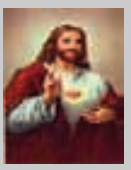
