I take this opportunity to share with you my thoughts about the Grade 8s legacy at St. Gregory School. As you might have seen on the evening news last Wednesday evening or read in the Shoreline News, the grade eights converted the entire front yard of the school into an environmentally sound outdoor classroom space, complete with native plantings, a fountain and ecologically friendly seating area. A beautiful cross that they themselves chose sits where all can see as they drive by. This was designed and constructed by the grade eights and their teachers. And I can tell you it is beautiful. I hope that when you drive into the St. Gregory Site that you take an opportunity to have a glance or take the time to walk through this wonderful space. You will notice that it is a beautiful addition to the neighbourhood and an integral part of the design was to make it completely accessible to the entire community. This was made possible with the help of individuals and groups who gave generously so the students could complete their plans. The pastoral team I were present at the blessing of this outdoor classroom and we were proud of these young men and women for what they had accomplished and how they prepared and lead this time of prayer with dignity and deep faith. We thank you Grade 8's and wish you the best as you move on in your education journey, you will be remembered in this legacy left behind.

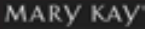
