ASCENSION OF THE LORD

June 5, 2011



Dear Friends:

Today we celebrate the Feast of The Ascension of Our Lord. This feast celebrates the day that Christ, in the presence of His apostles, ascended bodily into Heaven. The Ascension occurred on the 40th day of Easter so it falls on a Thursday, and thus is often called Ascension Thursday; however, in most dioceses in Canada and the United States, the celebration of the Ascension has been transferred to the following Sunday, six weeks after Easter 2011.

Jesus ascended to his Father and his heavenly throne, and now sits at the right hand of God the Father in heaven. An angel told the watching disciples that Jesus' second coming would take place in the same manner as his ascension, that is, He would descend in bodily form. This is also described in other Biblical passages. The Ascension of Jesus is professed in the Nicene Creed and the Apostles Creed. The Ascension implies Jesus' humanity being taken into heaven. The Feast of the Ascension is one of the chief feasts of the Christian year. Today's feast dates back at least to the later 4th century. As we celebrate this feast let us pray that the risen Christ will lead us to eternal life. As our opening prayer this weekend proclaims, God our Father, make us joyful in the ascension of your Son Jesus Christ. May we follow him into the new creation, for his ascension is our glory and our hope. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

I want to share something with you that truly moved my heart. Last week, I received an envelope with \$28.27 for the building fund. This came from Alexander, Samantha, Jocelyn Tapak, Noah Kljajic, and William Stanley all students of St. Gregory School. After seeing the presentation for the new Church a few weeks ago, they decided to help us build for our future, by holding a two day snow cone stand. The five of you are a real gift to this parish community of Good Shepherd. You make up an important part of our parish family today and in the future. Words cannot express my gratitude and I am sure the gratitude of each parishioner. Thank you for helping each of us, young and old, see that each of us has a part to play to build for our future. I know that God will truly bless you for your generous hearts.
