Dear Friends

You should have in your hands, any day now, our Holy Week Schedule for 2010. The Pastoral Team and I evaluate after each liturgical season, to see if we are meeting the needs of Good Shepherd Parish, and how better we can serve you. Holy Week is one of the most beautiful and spiritually moving weeks of the Church year. I hope you take the time to look at the schedule and make this week a priority in your life and the life of your family. The Easter Triduum, from Holy Thursday evening to Easter Sunday evening, constitutes a single act of salvation. Each of the days highlights individual aspects, but without ever surrendering a sense of the whole. I hope you will find time for our Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Celebrations and once again experience God's unconditional love for you.

I want to speak about a couple of changes to the schedule. First of all, the Good Friday morning schedule. This year we are offering, at both sites, a live presentation of the Way of the Cross, done by the youth of the Parish. Students from both sites, St. Gregory School, St. William School and St. Anne's High School, were invited to be part of this presentation. It is a great way to get our young people involved in the life of Good Shepherd Parish, build community and, at the same time in their weeks of rehearsals, have a religious experience themselves, as they prepare to present the Way of the Cross.

For this to take place at both sites, there had to be some changes made in times so our young people could move from site to site with costumes and props. You will see in your schedule that the time for the Way of the Cross will be at 9:00 am at St. Gregory Site and 11:30 am at St. William Site. I hope you will consider coming to experience this live presentation of the Way of the Cross, and support the young people of our parish. Communion will not be given at this service because it is the Way of the Cross, but reserved for the 3:00 pm Good Friday Celebration of the Lord's Passion at both sites. The Veneration of the Cross will be offered at both services.

I also take this opportunity to remind you that because we are serving two sites, our Easter Sunday Mass Schedule is the same as our Sunday Mass Schedule with overflow in our Parish Halls. We will have screens set up to provide those seated in our halls with the Easter Masses. If you want a seat in the main body of the Church, plan to arrive early.

We are no longer able to offer two extra Masses at St. Gregory Site in our Parish Hall at Christmas and Easter. Therefore, you will see large crowds at both sites. I look forward to the day when we can gather as one around the Table of the Lord to celebrate Holy Week in our new place of worship.

This coming week our Fundraising Committee begins Phase Two of our campaign. It is our hope to contact and meet with as many of our parishioners as possible throughout this phase. Your pledge is important to us and I hope you will give these dedicated volunteers a little of your time to listen to them, allow them to answer your questions, and more importantly, for you to consider your share in the responsibility to help build for our future.
