Dear Friends:

As promised a few weeks ago, I want to take this opportunity to bring you, up-to-date on the progress of our new home. The Building Committee and I have been meeting with our architect every two to three weeks for the last ten months and the building design is nearing completion. Roofing systems are being reviewed for durability and there will be a number of meetings dealing with this important issue coming up in the near future. We have also finished our site drainage and utility plans. At this time the Liturgical Committee is joining in the meetings with the Building Committee and architect to choose materials and finishes both interior and exterior. We are also finalizing the design of our liturgical items with the architect, such as altar and ambo and baptismal font, and incorporating alcoves designed specifically for our statues and our stations of the cross that we will be taking with us.

We have held several face to face meetings with the town of Lakeshore and the County of Essex over site access.

Unfortunately, this has taken more time than anyone on our professional design team anticipated and so our construction date has been pushed back. There are a number of meetings scheduled in the coming weeks and after those are completed I will once again share that information with you. Our Fund-raising Committee has also continued to do the hard work of raising money. Sunday evening's Pasta Dinner was a great success, thanks to our Downtown Mission Group who planned it, to our K of C who volunteered their time and to our Women's Auxiliary who baked those wonderful desserts. More than 350 people attended, more than last year. Our Fund-raising Committee is now using a shepherd's staff to show you our financial status. We place it in our bulletin on a regular basis and you can find it on our web-site.

I cannot thank our committee's enough for their hard work and dedication over the last number of years. As your Pastor I can tell you that a lot of time and effort have gone into this project. We are trying our best to build a home that you will be proud of and that it will serve future generations. We ask for your continued prayers and support as we work toward the completion of our new home.

On this Mother's day weekend I would like to wish all mothers of our Parish this blessing. Holy God, you compare your own love for your people to the love of a mother for her children. Look with kindness on these mothers, and give them comfort in moments of sorrow, and joy in their work for their families. Listen to their prayers and bless + them in all they do for you. Let them share with Jesus your Son and Mary our mother in the everlasting happiness of heaven. Father we ask this grace through Christ our Lord. Amen. I hope you will enjoy the day.

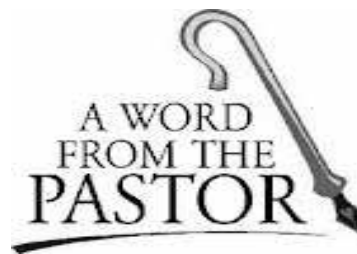
