Dear Friends: This past weekend we celebrated the ordination of two men to the priesthood for the Diocese of London, Tony Laforet and Ben Huyge. Fr. David celebrated his first Anniversary on Easter Sunday and last week I celebrated thirty two years of priesthood. Our dear friend Fr. Al will celebrate fifty-five years in June. We are grateful to the Lord for our years as priests and we thank you the people of Good Shepherd for your love support and prayers. We began our preparation for the priesthood at St. Peter's Seminary in London and St. Peter's Seminary continues to educate and prepare priests and lay people for service in the Church, not only for our Diocese, but for the Diocese across Canada. Each year St. Peter's has an appeal to help them continue their work. It was parishioners who made the Seminary a reality nearly a century ago, in 1912. Since then, generations of parishioners have supported the Seminary through prayer and financial donations. The Seminary continues its important mission, and needs our help.
