## FEAST OF CHRIST

### THE KING

November 20, 2011



Dear Friends:

On the last Sunday of the liturgical year the church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King. This Sunday helps us to look towards our future, our final destiny, when Jesus will return in glory for the final judgment and award to reach the reward or punishment. The Solemnity of Christ the King is a newer feast in the Catholic Church. This feast of Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 and is observed on the last Sunday of the liturgical year as it helps us to meditate on Christ the King and Lord and also on the Second and Final Coming of Christ, the Last Judgment, and the end of the world. The Pontiff was witness to a turbulent time in the world's history. The First World War had just come to an end. Secularism was on the rise and dangerous dictatorships were emerging in Europe and beyond. Christ had long been referred to as King, but Pope could see the respect and reverence for Christ's authority waning in the midst of the unrest during the early decades of the 20th century. In response, the feast was set with the intent to reaffirm and refocus faith and respect in the kingship of Jesus. Pope Pius XI felt that nations would see that the Church has the right to freedom, and immunity from the state. Secondly that leaders and nations would see that they are bound to give respect to Christ. Finally that the faithful would gain strength and courage from the celebration of the feast, as we are reminded that Christ must reign in our hearts, minds, wills, and bodies. Our world and each of us needs to see that Christ must be King in our lives.

We continue to share some changes in preparation for the New Roman Missal next Sunday. Last week we spoke about some textual changes. The priest invites us to "Pray that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the almighty Father." We will respond: "May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy church". We simply add the additional adjective "holy" to Church. This adjective is found in the original Latin and it is now returned to us in this third translation of the Missal. I also brought your attention to the words before the preface, we will now simply say. "it is right and just".

The second change in the Preparation Rite was about posture. We need to remember that throughout the liturgy there are specific postures that we hold in common. Using the same posture strengthens our unity and reflects an attitude of ecclesial solidarity. Together we celebrate the liturgy. We refrain from taking on a personal posture except for ill health or age. The common posture during the Preparation Rite is to sit. So we sit after the Prayers of the Faithful, the Universal Prayers, and only stand after the priest washes his hands. This will ready us to respond to his invitation to pray.

There are many times in the liturgy when we stand. Standing is a gesture of reverent attention. It is used when we receive Christ's Word proclaimed in the Gospel. It is a sign of great reverence as we process to communion. Standing at the end of the Preparation Rite readies us to offer our prayer to God.

Today at all Masses we introduce a gesture during the communion procession.
