Dear Friends:

At Mass this weekend Fr. David and I continued to use the changes introduced in the past few weeks. Those changes were first, the response, "Lord I am not worthy, that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul will be healed." And secondly, the response to "The Lord be with you" – "And with your spirit."

Today we begin to use the new words for the Confiteor, which is part of the Penitential Act of the Liturgy. There are really only a few words that change, and these will make our prayer before God a little more effusive as we acknowledge our sin. We will say "I have greatly sinned." We will also say three times "through my fault" while we tap our breast with a closed hand. This striking of the breast or heart is a long held tradition of the church. We only need tap the breast once. These repetitive words and hand gesture may help us grow more attuned to our relationships as we confess to God, the saints, and to each other as brothers and sisters. As we acknowledge that we have drawn apart from God during this past week, we find ourselves immersed in a community of gratitude and praise. Gratitude that we can once again gather in faith to celebrate God's desire to make us whole and one body. After the opening hymn we will be turning to page one in our folder, which will help us learn the new Confiteor.

Next week we will be learning the new text for the Apostles Creed. These changes will take some time for us to learn them by heart. Let us be patient with each other.

I would also like to take this time to remind our Extra-ordinary Ministers of the Eucharistic of the meetings planned to share with you some of the changes that will be taking place your ministry with the introduction of the New Missal. We have two meetings scheduled, the first is on Saturday November 12, 2011 at St. William Site from 10:30 am – 12noon. And the second on Saturday November 19, 2011 at St. Gregory Site. We ask that you **attend one of the two meetings**. Even though you might minister at the other site it does not matter. What is most important is that you attend. I thank you for being part of this important ministry in the life of the Church.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank our Ladies Auxiliary of our Parish for Raising **\$2,000.00** from their Thanksgiving Pie Sale and our Fundraising Committee for raising **\$3,575.00** at the Duelling Piano Dinner. Great job. Your hard work helps us get into our new home. Thanks for all the hard work.
