Dear Friends:

As mentioned at all the masses this weekend we continue to ready ourselves for the New Roman Missal on the first Sunday of Advent, by introducing the changes week by week. Those changes were first, the response: "Lord I am not worthy, that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul will be healed." And secondly, the response to "The Lord be with you" – "And with your spirit."

Today we began to use the new words for the Confiteor, which is part of the Penitential Act of the Liturgy. There are really only a few words that change, and these will make our prayer before God a little more effusive as we acknowledge our sin. We will say "I have greatly sinned". We will also say three times "through my fault" while we tap our breast with a closed hand. This striking of the breast or heart is a long held tradition of the church. We only need tap the breast once.

These repetitive words and hand gesture may help us grow more attuned to our relationship as we confess to God, the saints, and to each other as brothers and sisters. As we acknowledge that we have drawn apart from God during the past week, we find ourselves immersed in a community of gratitude and praise. Gratitude that we can once again gather in faith to celebrate God's desire to make us whole and one body. Next week we will look and begin using the new text for the Apostles Creed.

As mentioned before, change is difficult. Both Father David and I will do our best to give you as much background on the reasons for these changes. I know that after a few months, these changes will become familiar to us and my hope is that through these changes we will have a deeper appreciation for what we say and do as we celebrate the great gift of the Eucharist which has been handed down to us by Christ and the early church.

I hope that the extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist of our parish have received their new schedule. With it was sent a notice that there are two meetings set for you to go over some of the new changes in your role according to the New Roman Missal. I am asking that you attend one of the two meetings. The first meeting is set for Saturday, November 12. 2011 at St. William Site and the second is on Saturday, November 19, 2011 St. Gregory Site, from 10:30am — 12noon. You may attend either site for you convenience.

Finally, on Tuesday, October 25 at 11:00 am at St. Gregory Site we will be having our annual Mass of Anointing. This is a great time for our elderly, those recuperating from surgery, going through cancer treatment, dealing with a sick loved one, or mourning the loss of loved one, or needing spiritual and emotional strength, to come and receive this gift of healing. This Sacrament gives us strength and courage as we carry our daily crosses. Please bring loved ones that you know might appreciate this gift. You are also invited to join us for lunch in the Parish Hall following the Mass, provided by the CWL of our Parish.
