Dear Friends;

I want to begin today's message by thanking the Ladies Auxiliary for their generous donation to the building fund from their Thanksgiving weekend bake sale. Can you believe they raised \$1700.00? Thanks to all who provided the delicious desserts. I know that the three of us at the rectory really enjoyed the pumpkin pie. Your support is appreciated, and know that you will be remembered in my prayers and Masses.

I also want to take this opportunity to invite all our seniors and anyone in our parish who wishes to receive the Sacrament of the Sick, to our Mass of Anointing this coming Tuesday, October 26th at 11:00am (St. Gregory Site). As in the years past I would like to remind you who can approach the Sacrament. Here are some guidelines:

- +those who are dangerously ill
- +those who are advanced in years
- +those terminally ill or those who are in remission
- +those who are approaching surgery or tests
- +those suffering with physical or mental depression, anxiety or spiritual illness
- +those suffering from addiction/co-dependency
- +trauma of child birth/post-partum depression
- +fear of the future
- +anguish of a young parent whose child is sick/dying
- +those who have been devastated by divorce, separation, loss of a job
- +those who have suffered death of a loved one or struggling in the care of a loved one.

You can see that the Church offers a wide availability of the sacrament. The Anointing of the Sick is a different kind of healing than a chemical placed in the body as medicine or a surgical intervention to cut out diseased tissue. Sacraments are acts of faith. They grace the whole person body, soul, and spirit. The blessing of the oil of the sick states...make this oil a remedy for all who are anointed with it; heal them in body, in soul and in spirit and deliver them from every affliction. What gets healed? Not mere physical healings. God knows what kind of healing is needed most. A wound could be healed or that fear is turned to confidence. That loneliness is embraced by the support of a praying community. That confusion in the face of all the whys - Why me? Why suffering? Why now? - turns to insight. The sacrament of anointing does not remove the mystery of human suffering, yet its celebration gives us a window into the mystery of a loving God. Our loving God raises up the crucified Son to display his victorious wounds, sitting triumphant at the Father's right hand.

I hope you will come and join us for this celebration. The C.W.L. will provide a beautiful lunch in the parish hall following the Mass of Anointing. If you wish bring a friend along. Please come and join us.

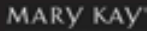
