Dear Friends:

Part of our new Pastoral Plan that our Parish Pastoral Council is still working on for Good Shepherd Parish, is trying to bring those who are working for the needs of the poor at each site together so that the whole Parish would be able to get involved and help meet the needs of these important endeavours. So last week we brought these key people together from both sites and discussed this possibility. I am excited to announce they look forward to working together and beginning this weekend we will start sharing some exciting new ways we can reach out to the poor especially as we draw closer to Advent and Christmas.

In last week's bulletin we announced Operation Christmas Shoebox. Some of you know about this (St. Williams Site) and for others it will be new for you. Each year, thousands of volunteers across Canada help to collect and prepare hundreds of thousands of these shoe boxes which are then shipped around the world to children in need. You will have heard more about this at the beginning of each Mass this weekend. We hope that you will consider taking a shoe box home and fill it with a variety of toys, school supplies, hygiene items and more. This is one way our children can help less fortunate children in different parts of our World. For Operation Christmas Child Shoebox to work and for these boxes to get out to the children before Christmas, our time period in returning these Shoe boxes will be very short. This weekend's announcement will give you the time line, and we are counting on you to help meet this time line.

After Operation Christmas Child Shoebox is completed Good Shepherd Parish will then begin to promoting "The Giving Tree" another special Advent project. This project has been taking place at both sites and many of you are familiar with the procedure. This project gives us a way we can meet the local needs of the poor. More information will be made available in the weeks ahead.

These projects give all of us different opportunities to meet the needs of the poor in our world and in our local communities. I thank those who are planning and organizing these opportunities for us, with them we can answer the call from last week's psalm to help the Lord hear the cry of the poor.

Friends beginning Monday November 1st I will be on an eight day retreat, followed by a week's holiday. I ask you to please keep me in your prayers as I promise my prayers for you. During my time away, be easy on Fr. David. I know he will do a great job in my absence.

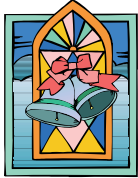

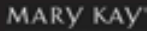
