Dear Friends;

As mentioned to you last weekend at all the Masses the heavy rains over the last few weeks have caused some major problems at both sites. The roof on the Hall at St. Williams is in need of a lot of repairs and so at this time we are unable to use it. As at St. Gregory Site, we are once again dealing large amounts of water under the worship space and added roof problems. On the weekend the walls at St. Gregory Site were wet and so were the vestments in the sacristy. As mentioned time and time again our buildings are at the point where patch work and trying to make them last a few more years are almost impossible. As pastor I have to make some difficult decisions over the next few weeks to see what we should do. I will pray and discuss these issues with the Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Committee and Diocese before I make any decisions. Thanks for your patience.

As mentioned a few weeks ago, we will be going to the Diocese this coming Thursday Sept. 22, 2011 for our meeting with the Finance and Building Commission of the Diocese. We are hoping to get the OK to move ahead in the Spring, especially with the conditions of our buildings. If you haven't given to the new Church your support would be greatly appreciated.

You will notice that in the entrances at both sites there is a sign regarding Poverty Reduction Awareness. Bishop Fabbro, has asked us the pastors of the Diocese to share the following information with you.

In 2009 the Government of Ontario, with the support of all political parties, passed Bill 152, an Act respecting a long-term strategy to reduce poverty in Ontario. Since that time, poverty reduction roundtables and other groups and organizations have worked to reduce poverty and to better the lives of those living in poverty.

With the coming provincial election, it is imperative that poverty reduction measures leading to the elimination of poverty in Ontario be kept at the forefront. Much has been accomplished in the last three years. We do not want this work to fall off the government's agenda regardless of which party comes into power.

The Inter-faith Social Assistance Reform Coalition (ISARC), representing the major religious faiths in Ontario, has made it possible for churches to participate in this important work of poverty elimination. ISARC is inviting churches to participate in the campaign to draw attention to the needs of the poor and the elimination of poverty. Also, as we prepare for the coming election we have available for you at the back of the Church some ways you can make sure your political party is following. We can make a difference in Ontario by our vote and our concern for others.
