The figure of Jesus is the Good Shepherd facing towards the right, leading us to the "future". The staff shows the promise of Jesus to Shepherd his flock. The two sheep represent our past history St. Gregory the Great and St. William Parishes that will now be in the hands of the Good Shepherd. The face of Jesus is in a shadow and we all pray to see his face some day.


