

Advanced Registration for Full-Day Kindergarten Program

Advanced registration for the 2017/18 Halton Catholic District school year has been set for January 24 & 25 from 8 a.m. to noon and 1:30 to 5 p.m. at the school. You must produce proof of child's age, updated immunization records (for diphtheria, tetanus, poliomyelitis, measles, mumps and rubella), proof of address and a Roman or Eastern Rite Catholic Baptismal certificate* (see note below). If the child has no Baptismal certificate, the child may be admitted if one parent can provide a Roman or Eastern Rite Catholic Baptismal certificate for themselves. Please visit www.hcdsb.org for more information.

*If you have lost the original Baptism Certificate for your child (<u>or</u> for a parent), contact the church of baptism for a replacement. *Please note*, many requests come in and are handled on a first-come, first-served basis. We are happy to assist you, however, churches do not keep copies on file, rather must produce a new certificate and this could take a number of days to be accomplished. If you have misplaced a baptism certificate, kindly request a replacement earlier rather than later so registration will not be delayed.


