

Preparations are under way for the "One Heart, One Soul" Campaign and across the Diocese, early returns are promising! Through mid-May, 14 Pilot Wave parishes had raised a total of more than \$2.5 million, and an additional \$1.6 million had been pledged by other Diocesan supporters and organizations. That total is about 12 % of the campaign's \$35 million goal. The Pilot Wave will run through June, and three larger, additional waves will follow as the campaign gathers steam and continues through early 2021.
