

An Examination of Conscience

The Gospel tells us to "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Do I stray from God in mind and heart? Do I busy myself with other things? Do I allow my anger and pain to reject God? Do I spend time in prayer? Do I participate at Mass on a weekly basis?

The Prophet Isaiah wrote, "It is I who wipe out your offenses, your sins I remember no more."

Have I failed to forgive? Have I failed to love? Do I hurt others through gossip and rash judgment? Do I indulge myself and neglect the needs of others? Do I neglect to care for the poor? Do I neglect to care for those in my family, my children, my spouse, my parents? Have I lived the values of this world, rather than those of the gospel? Have I sought my own will and not the will of God? Have I failed to speak the truth of Jesus Christ?
