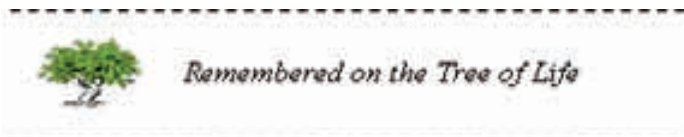

Stewardship - Dec 16, 3rd Sunday of Advent

Today is known as Gaudete Sunday. The term Gaudete refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon, 'Rejoice'. Rose vestments are worn to emphasize our joy that Christmas is near. We also light the rose candle on our Advent wreath. Indeed we have much to rejoice about during this time of year, the most important being "the reason for the season" - Christ Jesus. Yet, there are immense secular pressures to overdo it in the shopping malls. We can just pay for it later... right? In the face of all the excessive secular celebrating we rejoice in the gift of a stewardship way of life because it provides us with balance and discipline.
