

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick--no food, no sack, no money in their belts." Jesus gave the Twelve Apostles a remarkable mission. He sent them out two by two to preach repentance, to cast out evil spirits, and to heal the sick. And he made them do it in a spirit of complete dependence upon God. They were not allowed to take anything along that would have given them material comfort or security. These men--who did not even have the witness of other apostles or saints to inspire or give them courage, and who had not yet beheld the Resurrection of the Lord--stepped out into the world with literally nothing but their faith in this man named Jesus. And look what happened! "The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them."

The apostles' trust in God's power to work these miracles through their hands began with trust in God's power to provide for their own needs. Because they didn't have food, shelter, or money, every time they received food or shelter or had their needs met, the apostles were able to see that God was at work in their midst. This experience bolstered their faith and encouraged them in their mission.

When we find ourselves questioning whether we really have the "power" to do what God wants us to do, then we ought to step back and try to depend a little more directly upon God's providence. Tithing is one way to accomplish this. When we set aside a portion of our income for the sake of others, we make an act of trust in God's power to provide for us. Surrendering this element of care for ourselves allows God to meet our needs himself. And when he does, our faith will flourish too.

'Let There Be Light' PERSONALIZED PLANS. Some have inquired about purchasing a light fixture in thanksgiving for, or in memory of loved ones. A separate brochure outlining the various dedication options can be found at: the entrances of the church; listed below; at the parish office; or on our website at www.stmaryscathedralwpg.ca.

Our existing interior lighting in the cathedral and sacristy is being replaced with new energy efficient LED lights, and here is a way that you can assist financially with the cost of these fixtures. The cost of the entire project is \$100,502.00 plus applicable tax.

There are three types of fixtures being installed, plus power packs & a controller.

1. Large Fixtures in the high ceiling at \$960/per fixture.

Payment options available:

1 Payment @ \$960; Quarterly @ \$240; Monthly @ \$80; Weekly @ \$19

2. Smaller fixtures in the high ceiling and East/West lower ceiling at \$441 per fixture:

Payment options available:

1 payment @ \$441; Quarterly @ \$110; Monthly @ \$37; Weekly @ \$9

3. Lighting fixtures in the sacristy at \$942 per fixture.

Payment options available:

1 payment @ \$942; Quarterly @ \$236; Monthly @ \$79; Weekly @ \$18

4. Power Packs For Track Lights at \$110 per track:

Payment options available:

1 payment @ \$110; Quarterly @ \$28; Monthly @ \$10

5. Touch Screen Controller at \$267.

Payment options available:

1 payment @ \$267; Quarterly @ \$67; Monthly @ \$22
