



Jun 1, 2014 The Ascension of the Lord

"When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted." What a reassuring description! The first disciples knew Jesus in person, saw him after his res-



urrection and beheld his glorious ascension into heaven. Yet they experienced doubt. In the face of so much concrete "evidence," even these original witnesses struggled to have perfect faith in Christ. We too may have times when we find it challenging to believe. Trials and temptations may cause us to second-guess God's power. Perhaps the Gospel message, in the face of our sin, may appear too good to be true. But, like the disciples, we need not let such thoughts paralyze us. They doubted, but they worshiped too.

This is a relief. When we worship God, it doesn't have to "feel" perfect. We worship him because he deserves our adoration, our affection, or at the very least, our attention. We go to Mass and we pray as a way of giving something--however little--back to God. These acts of worship do not require that everything already be in order in our souls. On the contrary, the act of worship helps us to realign our spiritual compass. By praising and honoring God, we open ourselves to his presence, and train ourselves to recognize his action in our lives. Jesus responds to his doubting friends by putting his faith in them. He does not reprimand them or strip them of the title "disciple." Instead, he entrusts them with an important mission, the Great Commission: he sends them out to make more disciples. But he promises to give them what they need to do it. "I am with you always," he reassures them. We are also heirs of this promise. Jesus is here with us even now...believe it or not.
