Did You Know ...?

Today's first reading speaks about God's revelation, under the form of wisdom. St. Paul, in the letter to the Hebrews, speaks about the Word of God, as something that penetrates our being, calling us to intimacy with the Creator.

The Church teaches that Jesus is the total revelation of God and God's love for us.

We are invited to respond to God's love, revealed to us. We are free to accept or reject God's revelation in Jesus. Our free acceptance must encompass our whole being: mind, heart and body.

In accepting God's revelation we do not act alone. Our response, which is our faith, is born, nourished and sustained in our community of believers, which is the Church.

According to Catholic teaching, Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition are the two main sources of God's Revelation.

Sacred Scripture is the Word of God transmitted in the Bible through human beings who are writing under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

Sacred Tradition describes truths of our faith which are confirmed by the magisterium, and which although not necessarily made explicit in Scripture, do not contradict it.

St. Ignatius of Antioch urged early Christians to be centered in the living message of the Lord: "Make yourselves gentle, and be born again in the faith which is the body of the Lord and in love which is the blood of Jesus Christ"


