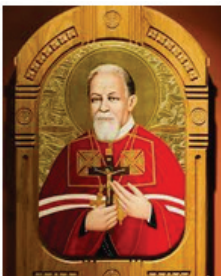
### Confessions for those being confirmed and Confirmation

We have a martyr's shrine only a few blocks away, at St. Joseph's Ukrainian Catholic Shrine. In lieu of what is currently happening in the Ukraine, we need to ask the intercession of Blessed Vasyl

### Knights of Columbus Aid to the Ukraine

The KOC have committed \$1 million of immediate aid to the Ukrainians impacted by the Russian invasion. The KOC have also launched the Ukraine Solidarity Fund, pledging to match all funds raised up to an additional \$500,000. So far, the fund has raised more than \$2.4 million, for a total of nearly \$4 million in assistance. The Knights in Poland are also delivering much-needed aid to those in Ukraine, and to those seeking refuge in Poland. The Knights have also established a housing network for refugees, along with "mercy huts" along the Ukrainian/Polish border to welcome refugees. Meanwhile, the KOC in Ukraine have coordinated the distribution of supplies through the "Anti-Crisis Committee", a group established by the Archdiocese of Lviv. One positive reaction to the crisis caused by Russia is the great good that has emerged from many hearts, as well as the solidarity of the KOC in their assistance. If you would like to contribute to the efforts of the Knights of Columbus in providing assistance to the Ukrainian refugees, you may do so through St. Anthony of Padua Parish. Mark your cheque: Aid to Ukraine. The parish will forward your gift to the Knights of Columbus to assist in their noble efforts to assist the refugees.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday)

**Introduction To Penitential Rite:** Father, you want us to be one in heart and mind and spirit, but we are frequently divided. We say and do divisive things. On this Mercy Sunday, we confidently ask for forgiveness.

**Acts 5:12-16** In the first reading, the apostles carry forward the saving work of Jesus Christ. They are able to heal everyone who approaches them in faith.

**Revelation 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19** In the second reading, John provides a vision of the glorified Jesus, his role in the Church, and in the world at large. Jesus encourages Christians to be faithful.

**John 20:19-31** In the Gospel, Jesus appears to his disciples after his resurrection. He offers them peace, and commissions them with the Holy Spirit to carry on his work.

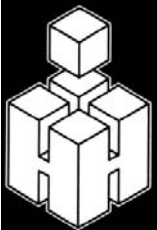
