From the Pastor's desk:

Solemnity of Corpus Christi

As has been our custom the last few years, following the 11 am Mass on Sunday, 23 June 2019, we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament around the block and end in the church with Benediction. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend and be a part of the celebration. Following the procession and Benediction there will be hot dogs and refreshments in the parish hall. You are encouraged to bring foods for a pot luck, like salads and desserts. Be sure to attend!

Archdiocesan Synod Summary

The synod was finished last year and booklet which you received last weekend at Mass entitled Disciples on the Way is the result of much time and hard work on the part of several people, not least of all our Archbishop Gagnon. The three themes are:

1. Forming the baptized as missionary disciples
2. Passing on the faith to the next generation
3. Reaching out to others, especially those on the peripheries.

The implementation of the synod is the work of each parish community. Together, our parish must pray, listen and discern in order to prepare and implement a parish plan. We will be looking at this aspect in September and determine what the Holy Spirit would have us do. In the meantime, let us be certain to read the document.

Sacred Heart of Jesus/Month of June

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is on Friday, 28 June; thus the month of June is referred to as the month of the Sacred Heart. St. John Eudes (1601-1680) promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart around the same time, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1673-1675) received apparitions of Christ telling her his concern about the indifference and coldness in the world in response to his love. Jesus asked her to be: devoted to his Sacred Heart, receive frequent Holy Communion in a spirit of reparation, especially on the First Friday of the month, and to make Holy Hours. Jesus also gave St. Margaret Alacoque twelve promises if devotion to his Sacred Heart is devotedly practiced. One of them is a happy death. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!

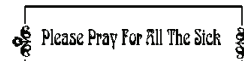


St Anthony KofC Council's 2019 Scholarship: St Anthony Council's knights, their daughters and sons, as well as their grandsons and

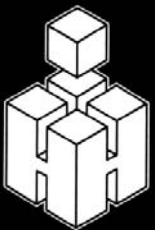
