Mass Attendance during COVID

Beginning Sunday June 21, we are allowed 50 people in the church.

In order to attend Mass, you must call the parish office during office hours to register for an available date. The secretary does not have the lists at home to check and see what days are available.

Please enter the parish office door to check in and sanitize hands before entering the church.

Please sit in the designated pews that are not roped off and remember social distancing. Families in the same household may sit together.

If your name is not on the list, you will not be permitted into the church.

If you are late, there is a chance you will not get in as the person greeting you will be attending Mass and the door will be locked to prevent more than 50 from entering the church, so please make sure to come early.

Even though we will be at 50 people, you still need to register for weekday Mass, government regulations require us to keep our lists for 21 days.

If you have already attended a Saturday or Sunday Mass and would like to attend again, your name will be put on a waiting list until all registered member have had a chance to attend

Thank you! We would like to thank Ron Monahan who spent many hours here measuring and marking the pews for us to make sure we were following the proper protocols for social distancing.

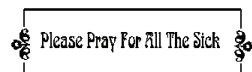

In our comparative freedom, do we nonetheless deny Christ or hide our faith in little ways? Mindful of Christ's promise and inspired by the faith of recent martyrs, may we acknowledge our Savior before others with serenity, courage and love.

This month, I challenge you to offer to keep another person's need in your prayers. Second, I challenge you to sustain the priesthood and its witness to the faith by supporting the Faith in Action Refund Support Vocations Program (RSVP) or by helping seminarians in some other way.

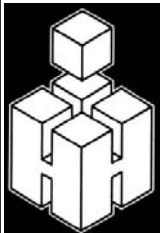
