From the Pastor's desk:

Sacred Heart of Jesus/Month of June

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is on Friday, 28 June; thus the month of June is referred to as the month of the Sacred Heart. St. John Eudes (1601-1680) promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart around the same time, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1673-1675) received apparitions of Christ telling her his concern about the indifference and coldness in the world in response to his love. Jesus asked her to be: devoted to his Sacred Heart, receive frequent Holy Communion in a spirit of reparation, especially on the First Friday of the month, and to make Holy Hours. Jesus also gave St. Margaret Alacoque twelve promises if devotion to his Sacred Heart is devotedly practiced. One of them is a happy death. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!

Feast of St. Anthony of Padua

The feast day of St. Anthony of Padua is this coming week on Thursday, 13 June. St. Anthony was born in Lisbon, Portugal. He was very moved when the bodies of the first Franciscan martyrs were brought to his town and decided that he wanted to give himself for the glory of God. He joined the Franciscans and started off to the missions, but he became ill and was then sent to Forli, Italy as a resident priest. Anthony lived an anonymous existence until the day that some Dominicans and Franciscans were gathered together for an ordination. For some reason or other, the assigned preacher never showed up and Anthony was chosen to give the homily. His homily turned out to be heart moving, provocative and deeply spiritual. Soon St. Francis contacted him and asked him to teach the brothers theology. St. Anthony became an unparalleled preacher. He had a profound inclination to help the poor, to defend the teachings of the Church and was a worker of miracles. Some 30,000 people came to hear him preach in Padua. St. Anthony died at the young age of 36 and was canonized a year later. He is invoked by the poor, those in distress, those who lose articles and for an abundant harvest. St. Anthony once said " Actions speak louder than words. Let your words teach and your actions speak." St. Anthony, our patron saint, pray for us!

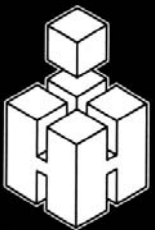
