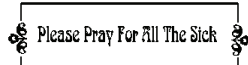
The Celebration mass "In Honor of Our Lady of Good Council" was held on April 29th. Thank you to all the CWL members who participated in this Celebration.

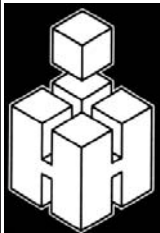
