Acts 2:1-11 In the first reading, the apostles receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. It gives them the power to preach the gospel in every language.

1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13 In the second reading, Paul speaks of conflict between self-indulgence and the power of the Holy Spirit. When we follow the Spirit, we are able to overcome temptation.

John 20:19-23 In the Gospel, Jesus appears to his disciples granting them peace. He commissions them to carry on his work, empowered by the gift of the Holy Spirit.

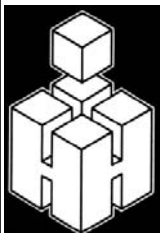
