Introduction To Penitential Rite: Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to remind us of all that he taught us in word and deed. Let us ask forgiveness for the times that we have failed to listen and learn.

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 In the first reading, the early church is troubled. But the Holy Spirit brings peace.

Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23 In the second reading, John sees the holy city Jerusalem coming down from God. The mention of the twelve apostles suggests continuity between God's work on earth and heavenly glory.

John 14:23-29 In the Gospel, Jesus assures the disciples that, when he departs, he will send them the Advocate who will teach them everything and remind them of all that Jesus taught.

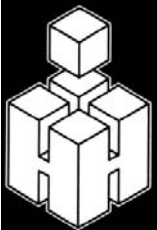
