Thanksgiving

I often mention that the word Eucharist means thanksgiving. Thus, we attend Mass to give God thanks for all the blessings received. Of course, we don't just wait until the Thanksgiving weekend to thank God, we give God thanks daily and especially on the Day of the Lord, which is Sunday. St. Paul tells us in the 1st chapter of Romans beginning at verse 20 that one of the triggers for the collapse of humankind was that they refused to give God thanks. Writing to the church at Colossae, St. Paul challenged the Christians there to give God thanks. He said that we should be "overflowing with thankfulness" Colossians 2:7. God's great kindness to us deserves our gratitude and a thankful heart. Everything that's good in life comes from God. Let us give thanks. Happy Thanksgiving to all faithful parishioners. I am grateful for all the parishioners who have resumed Mass attendance on Sunday, the Day of the Lord following the pandemic. Now that masks are no longer mandatory on air travel, let us hope that those remaining parishioners, still not attending Mass, will have trust in God who healed all who came to him with illnesses. No one gets sick in God's house because He is the great Physician. Also, we obey the 3rd commandment: "*Remember the sabbath to keep it holy*" which means we attend Mass on Sunday, according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Mass attendance on a weekday is not a substitute for our Sunday obligation.
