

## **EASTER SUNDAY**

**APRIL 8TH, 2012** 

Acts 4:32-35; 1 John 5:1-6; John 20:19-31

Though we know well the Easter story, we never fully grasp its meaning. The stone has been rolled back and the tomb is empty; resurrected life cannot be contained. Like the first believers, we so often continue to live with our dashed hopes and our misunderstanding of God's mysterious power. Like the first believers, we come to the tomb and expect to find death, but Instead we find signs of a new life that we cannot even begin to comprehend. Like the first believers, we do not realize that history has been broken open and is now filled with the resurrected presence of Christ. History no longer makes sense. The one who was maliciously singled out and shamefully hung on a tree was really the one set apart by God to judge the living and the dead. Who can comprehend such a paradox? But then, who goes to a tomb expecting to find life?

History has been broken open, and now we really do not know what to expect. This same resurrection power works in our own lives. "This is the day the Lord has made...it is wonderful in *our* eyes!" We too hear the Easter proclamation. By it we too are brought into the power of the resurrection.

#### MARY MAGDALENE, APOSTLE TO THE APOSTLES

In the four Gospels, Mary Magdalene is mentioned more often than most of the apostles, more frequently even than Mary, the mother of Jesus. There is no description of the "call" of Mary Magdalene by Jesus to be a disciple, as there is for several of the apostles. When we first meet her, she is already among several Galilean women who are journeying with Jesus, assisting him in his ministry. Mary is listed among the women who stay faithful to Christ at the end. As to why she, rather than one of the apostles, would go first to the tomb on Easter morning, it is because, when they were tested, the women around Jesus were more courageous than the men. While the apostles fled with fear, the women friends of Christ stood with him at the cross and accompanied his body to the tomb; then after taking the prescribed Sabbath rest, they went back early Sunday morning to anoint the body. Finding the tomb empty, Magdalene is charged by Jesus (Jn. 20:17) to "go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am going to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God'". Only after that do Peter and the mysterious "beloved disciple" dare to venture to the tomb, so St. Augustine rightly calls Mary Magdalene "The apostle to the apostles". Unfortunately, Mary's image has been confused through history by the inaccurate linkage of Mary with the unnamed "sinner" (commonly thought to have been a prostitute although the scripture text does not state this) in Lk. 7:36-50. That woman repents and thus anoints his feet with oil from her alabaster jar and dries them with her hair as a sign of joy. Mary Magdalene's memory and life of witness is celebrated by the Church on July 22.


