#### From the Administrator's Desk...

There is a common misconception among Catholics that the "God of the Old Testament" only cared about the Jewish people, and that it wasn't until Jesus came that the message of salvation was proclaimed to the whole world. Today's First Reading, from the prophet Isaiah, challenges that way of thinking. The prophet proclaims that any foreigners who join themselves to the Lord and keep the commandments will be accepted, for the house of the Lord is to be called a house of prayer for all peoples.

This theme is repeated numerous times throughout the Old Testament. We continually see God proclaiming that all nations on the earth will be blessed because of the actions of Abraham and the other patriarchs. The psalms continually speak about all the nations to the ends of the earth turning to God, and seeing his glory. Isaiah, in one of the servant songs, speaks about the servant of God becoming a light to the nations, so that God's salvation may be brought to the ends of the earth. Even our Psalm response today is asking God to let all the nations give him glory and praise.

With all this being said, how then do we make sense of Jesus' dismissive attitude toward the woman in today's Gospel? If God desires his message to be proclaimed to all nations, why would Jesus claim that he came only for the lost sheep of the house of Israel? This is especially puzzling when we consider that at this point in the Gospel narrative, Jesus has healed other gentiles. So why give so much resistance now?

I think the answer to that question lies in his response to the woman. His response is not one of resignation, or an indication that he has "changed his mind." His response echoes what we hear in the first reading: that those who have faith in God will be deemed acceptable by him. The woman demonstrates her faith by continuing to ask Jesus for help, even when she initially encounters pushback. Perhaps she knew about the passages in the Old Testament that spoke of God's care for all nations- or perhaps she was just stubborn. Whatever the case may be, her faith is rewarded, as her daughter's health is restored. Do we have that same faith when we face moments of difficulty in our lives?

I want to thank everyone who worked tirelessly to make the St. Angela festival such a success. It was wonderful to taking part in the festivities, and especially to have such a wonderful crowd at the outdoor Mass and procession. May St. Angela continue to intercede for us, and help us to grow closer to God.




