**Second Sunday of Lent
February 24, 2013**



Genesis 15:5-18; Ps. 26; Phil. 3:17-4:1; Luke 9:28-36

What is our potential as humans? Nothing less than a transforming relationship of love with God. When the Holy One comes close to us, we become new people. Abraham believed in God's word, and for his faith was promised the future. Faith bring us into the presence of the living God; to seek his face should be our resolve this Lent. In the gospel of Luke, the transfiguration is closely linked with the agony in the garden, when Jesus will again converse with God in the presence of his three friends. Here on this mountain a change comes over the Lord in the course of prayer.
