Jonah 3: 1-5,10; 1 Cor 7: 29-31; Mk. 1:14-20



There is an urgency in today's readings. Unless we embrace the gospel now and live it fully, we may run out of time. As disciples we are called not only to enter the reign of God but to promote it and to spread it. We are ambassadors of God; we bring

the good news of salvation, and we do this wherever we are and in whatever we do. Having been called by God, we now begin to live our lives in a totally different way, guided by the values of the reign of God rather than those of the world that is passing away.



Music at Assumption: after many years of significant contribution to Assumption, Fred Mooney will be leaving us. Certainly our liturgical celebrations have been enriched because of Fred and our parish wishes him the very best. In this time of transition, I ask for your patience as we search to fill this position. Since we could no longer sustain the expense of a paid professional choir, I am hoping we can return to the tradition here at Assumption of a volunteer choir. 

Low Gluten Altar Breads: a few parishioners have inquired about this. I have found that the Benedictine Sisters in the US make them (less than 0.01% gluten content) which are approved for use at Mass. These are now available at Assumption Church. For any wishing to receive these hosts the procedure is: after giving communion, the priest goes to the tabernacle to return the ciborium. Simply come up and follow the priest to the tabernacle and he will give you the consecrated low-gluten host. Then return to your seat.
