As a little boy, I prided myself on being good. My parents tried long and hard to have children. My mother had to have two surgeries in order to become pregnant; then she had two miscarriages, followed by a son who died the day he was born. Then a year-and-a-half later I was born. From the very beginning of my life, I knew I was wanted and loved. I also decided early on that I didn't ever want to disappoint my parents. I had to be the perfect son!

Of course, I wasn't. I, like everyone else, have my weaknesses and flaws. As a teenager I tried different things that I knew my mom wouldn't like me doing—and I had to keep it all a secret, because I thought I should never disappoint her. There was probably plenty of egoism mixed in there, too. I thought that if I ever let people find out I wasn't perfect that I would no longer be special; I'd no longer be loved and loveable.

Our readings this month begin with the exact opposite. Paul boasts about his weakness, not his strength. And in the Gospel, people get indignant about Jesus because they know him and think he's just an average guy. For me, *those are key truths of our faith*. God seems to get it all wrong. I try and make myself powerful and strong in my faith. I want to do good. Then Paul comes along and says that it is in his weakness that God's strength can shine forth. And when God comes to us in the flesh, it is not in power and glory and might. Instead, it is in Jesus, the carpenter's son, Mary's son, who grew up in Nazareth, who played when he was a little boy, who had family and relatives—in short, who was *human*.

I want God to come as totally other, and instead God comes to me disguised as my life, as author and speaker Paula D'Arcy says. I don't have to look any further. God is right here, in the ordinariness of my day-to-day life, in my strength and in my weakness.

This month we welcome Fr. Jim Stenberg, our new Parochial Vicar, to Assumption. He will be here by the time you read this, and will stay until I return from my trips: first, a family wedding in Belgium, followed by meetings in Toronto. Fr. Jim comes to us directly from Holy Rosary parish in Toronto. Once I return mid-month, he will be leaving for well-deserved holiday time. Kevin Mannara, a Basilian seminarian, will also be joining us this summer and will be part of the pastoral team at Assumption for one or two years. I ask for your prayers for all of us, and assure you of mine for you. May Our Lady, Jesus' mother, fill us with the grace to recognize her Son in every moment and every aspect of our lives.
