Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

June 14, 2015



I'm glad that we've returned to Sundays in Ordinary Time. I love the gentle progress that we make through the Gospel and the Second Reading. (In Ordinary Time, both the Gospel and Second Reading are semi-continuous; the First Reading is chosen to reflect a theme of the Gospel.) We use the liturgical colour of green, signifying hope and growth. I think this is significant for us here at Assumption parish. In a time when buildings are closed, attendance and collections are down, we need hope; we need growth.

There are times when the future looks bleak. We look back at what seem like the glory days: Assumption, Holy Name of Mary, St. Patrick, and Blessed Sacrament were all thriving parishes. There were priests and parishioners and Masses and everything was good. Then, society changes: we have fewer people; there are structural problems; there are tough financial times for Windsor. Before you know it, parishes are merged and moved. There is no money to repair and restore and renovate. There are fewer and fewer priests as well, and many of those left are getting old and are ready to retire.

Paul, though, writing to the Church in Corinth, reminds them—and us—that we walk by faith, not by sight. St. John of the Cross, in his "Dark Night of the Soul," says that there are times when everything looks bleak because if we thought something was happening, we would want to get in there and "help." Instead, God lets us think that nothing is happening, and all the while is busy at work preparing a future for us. It is in a way like the grain that grows. Although many farmers here in Essex County know more about how the seed becomes the plant than people did in Jesus' day, the principle still holds: We sow the seed, work the soil and tend the plants, and somehow or another, a mature plant brings forth a harvest.

What might God have in store for us? If we are led by faith, we may just be surprised at the answer.

Presented by Dr. Sheldon Solomon

Dr. Sheldon Solomon is a professor of Social Psychology who teaches at Skidmore College. 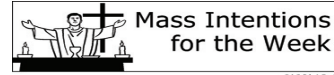
