# Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## June 28, 2015



Just before sitting down to write this I was with a dying man. I got back to my office and looked at the readings. The Book of Wisdom states: "God did not make death, and he does not delight in the death of the living." Any of us who have experienced the death of a loved one knows how hard it is. I remember watching my father take his last breath, when I was only 13; I kept asking, "Why?" Many years later, arriving in the hospital room to see my mom's dead body lying on the bed, I asked what the point of all this is. Is there even a God?

Over and over again in our Scripture and Tradition, we are told that God is a God of life, not of death. Today's Gospel reading tells us of Jesus bringing a little girl back to life and healing a woman. So, if God can do that, why is there still death today? Didn't St. Paul tell us that Christ's death overcame all death? I don't think there are any simple answers to those questions. I remember once hearing that a "perfect human" is like a "square circle." It simply doesn't exist. The fact that we are the created rather than the Creator means that we are not THE One; we are imperfect. The greatest example of our imperfection is our death. We are not eternal.

Yet... our faith tells us that *something* in us lives on. We are created in God's image and likeness, after all. We talk about an immortal soul. This language helps us to formulate in human terms something that is actually greater than our minds can conceive: we are, *at the same time*, both unlike God and like God. We are flawed and mortal and yet perfect and immortal. We are both *created*, receiving life from God and others, and *creator*, giving life to others. We are such sinners, and yet God loves us just the way we are. We are paradox. And that paradox carries into every corner of our lives, not just in the "big" questions of our existence. Changing themes, I wish all the students beginning their summer vacations a time of renewal and enjoyment. May you have a blessed and joy-filled summer.

As we all celebrate Canada Day on July 1 (even though the fireworks were this past week), may we rejoice in all the good that Canada is and offers, and repent of our imperfections. Pray for me as well. I will be at a family wedding in Belgium. I look forward to seeing you all in mid-July. Lastly, *welcome to our new Parochial Vicar, Fr. Jim Stenberg!!!*

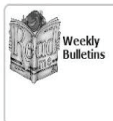
