June 7, 2015 The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)



My mom used to laugh at my dad's remedy for everything: "Eat something!" Even though he died many years ago, I can still hear his voice. Got a stomach ache? "Eat something, boy." Headache? "Eat something!" Tired? "Eat!" I guess he learned from his mom. The one word of hers that stays in my memory was "*Mangia!*" Any time there was a large family gathering, it seemed to focus around a huge meal. These events did far more than feed our bodies; they fed our souls, too.

For most of us, the meal remains important. In these last few days of Fr. Don's time here, it was punctuated by meals: eating out, eating in, celebrating his presence here and wishing him well as he returns to St. Joseph's College by "breaking bread" together. Perhaps the most common complaint I hear about today's society is that it is harder to eat together. Because of busy schedules we grab fast food and eat on the run. Different members of the family eat at different times. The family seated around the table every night has become the exception rather than the rule in many households.

And in the midst of this reality, the Church presents us with this weekend's celebration: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, often known as *Corpus Christi*. When I was a boy I remember the processions we had downtown, organized by the Holy Name Society. We would process with the Blessed Sacrament, with Christ in the sacramental form of bread.

Today's solemnity, however, invites us to do more than only recognizing Christ in the consecrated host, as important as it may be. The gospel passage focuses on Jesus' command to *eat* and to *drink*. Maybe my grandma learned from Jesus. He is saying, "*Mangiate! Eat! Drink!*" We come together as a community, as the community of Assumption Parish, and we are told to eat and drink. May this incredible food unite us and give us life.
