From the Pastor's Desk...

Happy Lent! As Pope Francis states in his message for Lent (quoting from the First Preface of Lent), "Each year, through Mother Church, God 'gives us this joyful season when we prepare to celebrate the paschal mystery with mind and heart renewed... as we recall the great events that gave us new life in Christ'." In the Church, we talk about "prayer, fasting, and almsgiving". I enjoy Lent. It is a time when I focus more on what is important; I usually do some form of fasting, to remind myself that I need to be hungry for God. Whatever it is you choose to do, whether giving up something (food or time or dessert or ...) or adding some practice (prayer, a work of mercy, etc.) I encourage you to choose *something*. And if you fail at it, just start over. *Don't give up easily*! All of these things should help us to adjust our attitude.

Last weekend in his homily, Deacon Paul mentioned a line in Pope Francis'message: "Let us not allow this season of grace to pass in vain!" In an effort to fulfill the pope's exhortation, this year we will be looking at *Attitude Adjustment*, in our homilies, in small groups, youth activities, and other opportunities. It is an effort to grow in *humility*, to foster this attitude in our lives. Humility is a virtue that is rather elusive: the more I think I have it, the less I probably do! And once I realize I have it, if I try to rest comfortably in the knowledge that I have it, to thank God for this great virtue, I've lost it! I encourage you to be open during this season, to make this year's Lent a time of growth towards God.

It has been a while since I've updated you on the progress concerning Assumption church. While Paul Mullins continues his efforts to contact potential donors, we need realistic numbers. This past week you may have seen activity at the church. It was necessary to test the plaster to ascertain its present condition, to know both how much restoration needs to be done, and whether or not it is safe as it stands now. We cannot have figures on actual restoration costs until we have a reliable assessment of the present condition. My hope is that there has not been significant deterioration of the church since it was closed in November of 2014; this plaster assessment and other testing will give us a realistic appraisal of the work needed. As always, pray for openness to the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we make decisions concerning our parish home.

Be with me, Lord, when I am tempted (Ps. 91) Let us be attentive to the Holy Spirit and ignore the idols that strive for our attention.



After a bowl of hearty soup we will share some of our Madonna House traditions and prepare for Easter using the Sunday readings as a jumping off point for our discussions.

Pysanky Classes

Madonna House is once again offering pysanky classes Saturdays during Lent from 1:00pm-3:00pm. Pysanky is the ancient Eastern European art of egg decorating. The name comes from the verb to write, as you use a stylus (called a kistka) to write with wax on the egg shell. The process is similar to *batik*. Come and push back the darkness and create a beautiful egg to decorate for Easter.
